Dear Ms. Poppe,

Congratulations on the recent decision by Governor Gavin Newsom and the California legislature to continue operation of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, the crown jewel of PG&E's power generating assets.

I am writing to inform you that Environmental Progress has decided to award our Courage Award to the workers at Diablo Canyon for their important work operating the plant over the last six years, a period in which the plant was slated for premature closure.

We would like to award the workers with this recognition at the plant itself during a lunchtime ceremony on Tuesday December 6 or Wednesday December 7. We hope you would consider accommodating such the award ceremony at the plant on one of those dates, and that you will yourself consider attending.
